While the efforts must be behind the scenes, we believe that it is important to let you know what is happening. We have/are expending considerable resources and manpower to solve this issue. If you would like to help speed up the resolution of the interference, please see more below. We have devoted time and effort to the jammer problem which has slowed upgrades and maintenance to our repeater system. We have been in contact with the FCC and are actively collecting evidence, suffice to say that we are doing what we can. Believe us when we say that we are also frustrated by this illegal behavior. We will eventually succeed as we have with other jammers!

For Colorado Springs 144.53
